Each **free** workshop includes a downloadable teaching pack with:

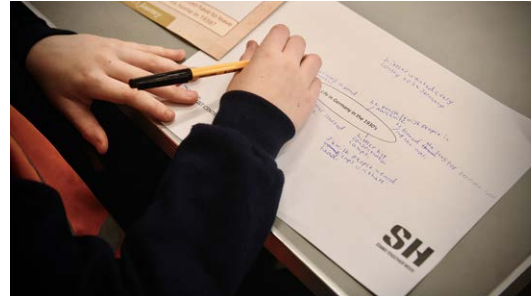
- a short commemoration ceremony filmed at South Hampstead Synagogue

### Years 5 and 6

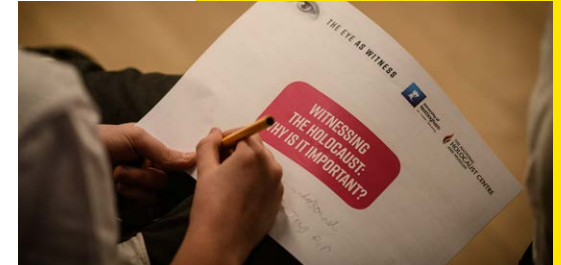
